CORREDOR VERDE RÍO SEGURA



46,84 KMS - 96 M elevation gain

Orihuela - Guardamar - Murcia Green Corridor . The vast expanse of the Segura River's

different gravel mountain bike or mixed bike routes to be enjoyed, taking in the landscapes of the orchards and nature.





ORIHUELA - EMBALSE DE LA PEDRERA - LA ZENIA - RINCÓN **HERNANDIANO**



80,72 KMS - 782m elevation gain

This route takes us to the coast, passing through La Pedrera Reservoir, cycling along excellent

secondary roads with very little traffic. The turning point of this cycling day will be when we arrive at La Zenia beach.





ORIHUELA - PUERTO DE ALBATERA



73,7 KMS - 731 M elevation gain

Passing through Rincón Hernandiano, we will then follow the road cycling route, especially for MTB,

mixed or gravel bikes, and this will lead us to one of the most demanding mountain passes in the area, Puerto de Albatera, with some difficult final very kilometres.





ORIHUELA - CAPRES -GARAPACHA - PEÑA ZAFRA



142,5 KMS - 1.757M elevation gain

Road cycling route through the Sierra de la Pila area, with the climb to the village of Capres,

Garapacha and Peña Zafra.









ORIHUELA - LOS DESAMPARADOS

10,57 KMS - 52 M elevation gain

A very accessible bicycle route along the cycle path that links Orihuela with the towns of Los Desampa-

Perfect for sustainable mobility between municipalities. As well as to get to know part of Orihuela's natural heritage.





ORIHUELA - CAMINO DEL CID

89,90 KMS - 451 M elevation gain

Route for road bikes with historical touches through the Camino del Cid and the Defensa

del Sur, following the line of castles that opens out in these territories.





PLAYAS DE ORIHUELA - TORRE VIGÍA



26,88 KMS - 295 M elevation gain

Mountain bike route, which starts off at Orihuela Costa Town Hall along the cycle path and the

bicycle boulevard that then takes us to the coastal area, where we will visit the entire coastline and beaches of Orihuela, passing by Cabo Roig Tower.







96,7 KMS - 225 M elevation gain

Cycling route from Orihuela until reaching the town of Caravaca de la Cruz, in the region of

Murcia A route that combines religious character, with nature, sport and heritage.





ORIHUELA - SENDA AMARILLA -SIERRA DE ORIHUELA



25,56 KMS - 801 M elevation gain

Mountain bike route that takes us to the Orihuela mountain range and one of its routes:

the Yellow Trail. It is not a lengthy route in kilometres but has very steep sections.





ORIHUELA - CRESTA DEL GALLO - SEMINARIO DIOCESANO



87,30 KMS - 1.143 M elevation gain

Route for road bikes with a visit to the area of Murcia and with the ascent to the Cresta de

Orihuela with another small ascent to the Diocesan Seminary that will allow us to enjoy beautiful views of the town.
